

When the staff meet to create tentative class lists for September 2025, we will take into consideration the overall needs of the students in relation to the make-up of the class. We will also take into consideration parental input regarding a student's special needs.

<u>Thursday, April 24th</u> – Eco-Friendly snacks/GOOS Paper Day


Students are asked to bring in snacks that leave a smaller Eco-impact on our world. Choose local fruits and veggies and snacks with little or no packaging
